It is located in the village of Ardfert Co. Kerry, just a few miles away from Tralee.

We can park our car on the street nearby.

We will step out into the middle of the Cathedral ruin.



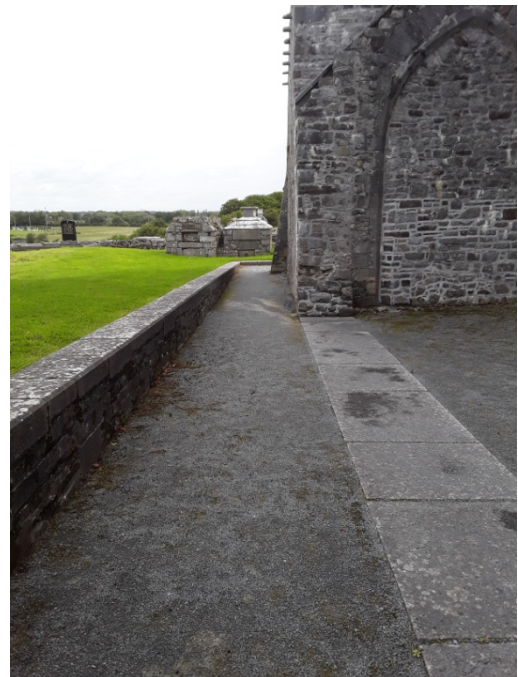
Now we can explore! There will be lots of interesting things to see.
