Grangegorman Military Cemetery Tour

Before you start your tour, you will meet your tour guide inside the gate of Grangegorman Military Cemetery.



Once inside the gate, your guide will give some health and safety announcements and your tour will begin, starting with an introduction to the history of the cemetery.



Throughout your tour, your guide will stop at several graves and tell you a bit about the people who are buried there. One of the first people mentioned will be Martin Doyle, whose grave is found in the first section of the cemetery on the left hand side, behind this building, which used to be the mortuary.





As you walk through the cemetery, your guide will tell you about different events connected with the history of the site, including the sinking of the mailboat the RMS Leinster, and the 1916 Rising.







On the way back towards the main gate, your guide will stop at a memorial to some those who lost their lives in World War I and World War II but who are buried elsewhere.



Your guide will then lead your group back to the main entrance of the cemetery.



Once the tour is over, feel free to continue walking around on your own if you would like. If you have any questions please ask, as all of the guides love questions!
