

Exhibition Buildings

There are three exhibition buildings for us to visit at Charles Fort.

1) The Barrack Stores



This building has steps leading up to the main entrance door. There is also a ramp on the right leading us through the side door.

Inside we can learn about the history of Charles Fort. There are videos to watch, information panels to read and artefacts to see. We will not touch the artefacts, as they are fragile. Some of the artefacts are kept in glass cases for protection.



There is a lift in this building to bring me up to the first floor. We can ask a Tour Guide to operate the lift.

2) Fire Engine House



The next exhibition building is the old Fire Engine House. Inside is an original fire engine dating from 1850. There are also information panels for us to read about Charles Fort during the First World War.

3) The Gunpowder Magazine



Inside this strongly fortified building, we can learn how gunpowder and cannon were used. We can also see photographs of the soldiers and officers who lived here in Charles Fort 100 years ago.
